Tiffany studied at CSS between 2006-2012, and was a member of Bombax. She was an active student in Theatre Arts, and repeatedly took on performance roles, such as Tallulah in Bugsy Malone, Frenchy in Grease, and Chorus Leader in Arsonists. She went on to study at University of Birmingham, and now working as a Freelancer, and ISF Drama Teaching Intern.

"I don't believe there is such a thing as an 'ordinary life'. We all go on a different journey with different people, and contribute to the world through different ways.

I contribute to the arts by bringing the skills I learned from overseas back to Hong Kong. I spent most of my time working indoors, inside a black box, from 09:00 to 23:00.

I graduated from the University of Birmingham in 2016 with a degree on BA Drama and Theatre Arts. I, then, did a Master on theatre directing in the same institute. 7th years ago I realised my interest in this form of arts. From the disapproval from my parents in pursuing performing arts as a career to the failure in leading a drama workshop in the UK, I have been through a lot before I reached this point in life. In 2015, I wrote, produced, directed and performed my first 45 minutes solo piece publicly in Hong Kong. It was not as successful as I thought it would be. In 2016, I gathered a team of talents to work on a show with me about the old Hong Kong... If I keep listing big events that happened in my life after graduated from CSS, I can probably write an essay of a 1000 words. I will stop here, before you lose interest in this article. But this is my life, as a theatre practitioner."
